For the past two decades, the team at Shoreline has been committed to providing an excellent holiday experience to our guests including those with dogs.

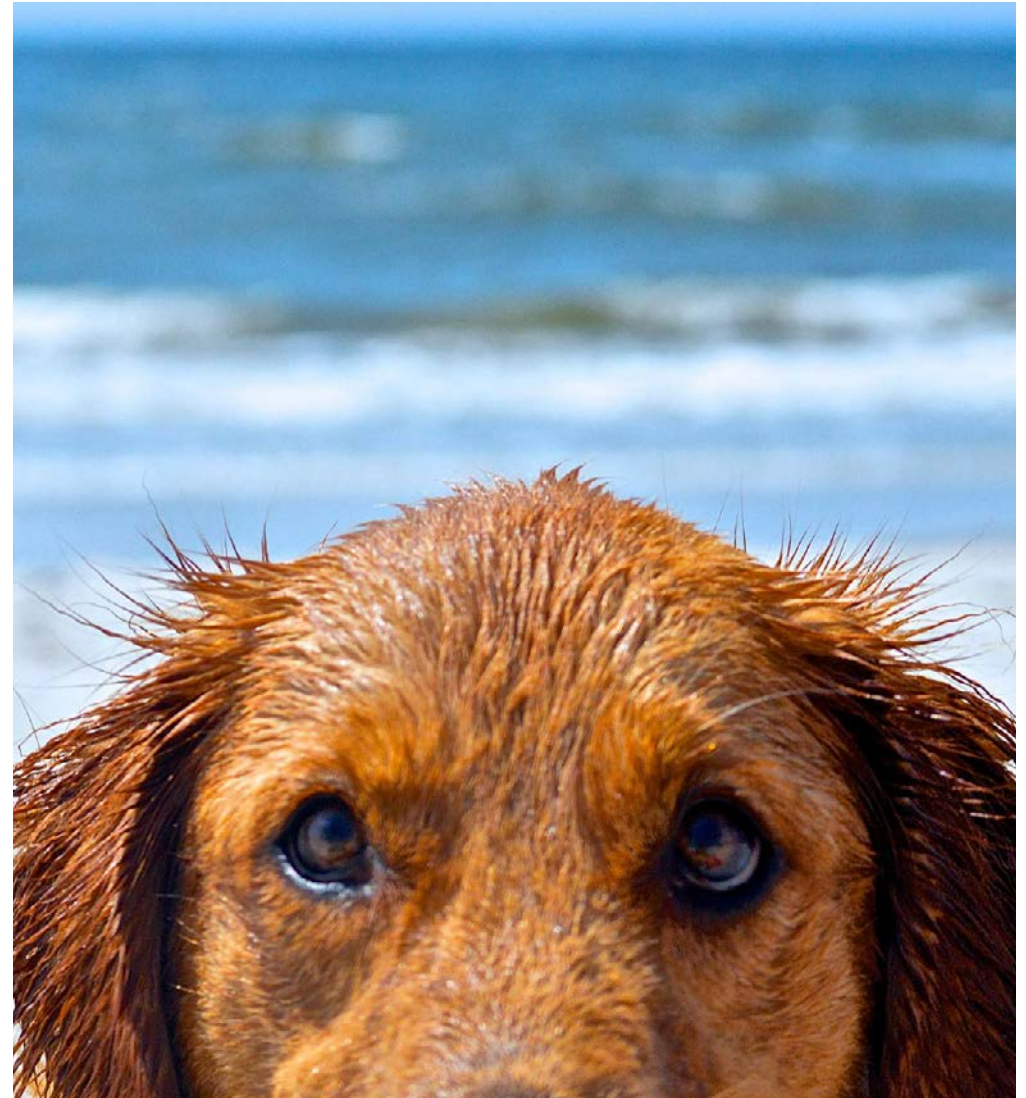

Popular dog walks and seasonal beach restrictions



Whitby to Sandsend

This walk will take you along the beach from Whitby to the nearby village of Sandsend. The walk will offer you beautiful views of the sea, cliffs, and local wildlife. This walk is fairly flat and suitable for most abilities. Enjoy the spectacular views of the ruins of Whitby Abbey, and the dramatic coastline.

As this seaside route is extremely popular with dog walkers, the chances are you will meet other dogs along the way for your furry friend to play with. Make sure to check if the tide is out before you set off on your walk.

Length: 3.5 miles

Restrictions: Beach is open for dogs from October 1 to April 30

May Beck and Falling Foss

This idyllic walk takes you through the trees and woodland, to the Falling Foss waterfall. Your dog will enjoy the shallow waters.

Please be aware that there are sheep in the woodland and steep drops near the waterfall, so keep your dogs close on the lead for safety reasons.

Length: 2 miles

Restrictions: None

Staithe to Whitby

A moderately difficult walk along the cliff top path. The path follows the cliff edge, providing walkers with an amazing view over Staithe, Port Mulgrave, and Runswick Bay's sandy beaches.

At Hob Hole you have to cross the stream by walking on the stones, so make sure to wear appropriate footwear, as the path may be wet and slippery.

The walk finishes in Whitby. If the tide is out, you can walk on the sandy beach. If not, there is a pavement next to the road. We recommend checking the local tide times before starting your walk.

Length: 10 miles

Restrictions: Beach is open for dogs from October 1 to April 30

Popular dog walks and seasonal beach restrictions

Whitby to Robin Hood's Bay

A 7-mile walk, that takes you through very varied scenery. You can expect to walk by the river, along the top of the rocky cliffs, and to see a waterfall.

The walk finishes in the picturesque Robin Hood's Bay, where you can pop in the tourist shops and enjoy local fish and chips before heading back to Whitby. If you are too tired to make your way back on foot, there is a regular bus service from Robin Hood's Bay to Whitby.

The beach in Robin Hood's Bay is open to dogs 365 days of the year.

Length: 7 miles

Restrictions: None
